Concerned About a Loved One's Safety?

You may be able to help prevent firearm-related harm. If you are experiencing an emergency, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency department.

In Massachusetts an Extreme Risk Protection Order (ERPO), also known as a red flag order, is an order from a judge that requires someone to surrender any licenses to carry firearms, firearms identification cards, and all firearms or ammunition they control, own, or possess.

Why Consider Filing an ERPO? **SAFETY**

- **S** see the warning signs
- A act early
- **F** file to pause firearm access
- **E** explain it's not punishment
- **T** temporary pause
- **Y** you're not alone
